What We Teach — Family


We believe that God created and blessed the family as the foundation of society.

A three generation unit built around three different but complementary relationships.




The "Real" Family Trinity (in process)

Often a complex, multigeneration and nonnuclear unit built around many different and evolving relationships.





Doing Life with Your Adult Children



You no doubt will experience bewilderment when your grown kids violate your values or live differently from how they were raised, but your goal must remain the same: to help your children transition to responsible adulthood.

You're Fired!

PRINCIPLE 1: YOUR ROLE AS THE PARENT MUST CHANGE

- Be encouraging but not intrusive
- Be caring, but do not enable dependency
- Invest in your emotional, physical and spiritual health
- Have serious fun

PRINCIPLE 2:
UNSOLICITED
ADVICE IS USUALLY
TAKEN AS CRITICISM

- Trust that experience is a better teacher than advice
- Give respect: No adult wants to be told what to do
- You are now a mentor and a coach
- Your words have the power to bless and to curse

"Since she already knows how you feel, take her to dinner once a week and talk about other things."


Level of Celebration




